# STATE OF ILLINOIS EDUCATIONAL LABOR RELATIONS BOARD

### Minutes of the Meeting held on March 21, 2019 At 160 N. LaSalle Street, Suite N-401, Chicago, Illinois

#### I. PRESENT

### II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF MEETING HELD FEBRUARY 21, 2019
