1. Western Illinois University/UPI, Local 4100, IFT-AFT, AFL-CIO, Case No. 2021-CA-0009-C

General Counsel Ellen Strizak presented a draft opinion and order. Board Member Sered called for a motion for the Board to adopt and issue the opinion and order. 2. Chicago Teachers Union, Local No. 1, IFT-AFT, AFL-CIO/Chicago Board of Education, Case No. 2021-CA-0014-C

General Counsel Ellen Strizak presented a draft opinion and order and noted changes that were made.
