#### Minutes of the Meeting held on October 17, 2013 At 100 W. Randolph Street, Chicago, Illinois

## I. OPENING OF THE MEETING AT 10:00 A.M.

### II. <u>PRESENT</u>

Chairman Lynne Sered; Board Members Ronald Ettinger and Michael Prueter; Executive Director Victor Blackwell; General Counsel Helen Higgins; Special Counsel John Brosnan; staff members Colleen Harvey and Susan Willenborg; Andrew Cantrell, Kelly Coyle and Andrew Slobodien were present. Observer Lisa Daykin participated via videoconference from the Board's Springfield's office. Pursuant to Section 7(a) of the Open Meetings Act, 5 ILCS 120/7(a), Board Members Gilbert O'Brien and Michael Smith participated via telephone conference call due to illness.

### III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF MEETING HELD SEPTEMBER 19, 2013

Chairman Sered called for a motion to approve the minutes of the September 19, 2013 meeting. Member Prueter moved to approve the minutes of the September 19, 2013 meeting. Member Ettinger seconded the motion. The Board passed the motion unanimously, by a voice vote.

## IV. BOARD ACTIONS

### 1. <u>Chicago Board of Education/Gora</u> Case No. 2011-CA-0058-C

Chairman Sered called the case. Associate General Counsel Susan Willenborg presented a draft opinion and order affirming the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Decision and Order dismissing the amended complaint in part and sustaining it in part, with one qualification. After discussion, Chairman Sered called for a motion to approve the draft. Member Ettinger so moved, and Member Prueter seconded the motion. The Board voted unanimously to issue the draft opinion and order, by a voice vote.

#### 2. <u>Chicago Board of Education/Zito</u> Case No. 2013-CA-0036-C

Chairman Sered called the case. General Counsel Helen Higgins presented a draft opinion and order striking the Charging Party's exceptions to the Executive Director's Recommended Decision and Order dismissing the charge and affirming the Executive Director's decision. After discussion, Chairman Sered called for a motion to approve the draft. Member Prueter so moved, and Member Ettinger seconded the motion. Chairman Sered called the cases. These were unappealed Executive Director's Recommended Decisions and Orders dismissing unfair labor practice charges and an unappealed Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Decision and Order determining the amount of fair share fees that a union could charge nonmembers. General Counsel Helen Higgins presented the cases. After discussion, Chairman Sered called for a motion for the Board not to take the cases up on its own motion and to issue final orders. Member Ettinger so moved, and Member Smith seconded the motion. The Board voted unanimously, by a voice vote, not to take the cases up on its own motion and to issue final orders.

Member Ettinger so moved, and Member Prueter seconded the motion. The Board passed the motion unanimously, by a voice vote.
