### I. PRESENT

## II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF MEETING HELD JANUARY 16, 2020

# 2. <u>Local Education Association of District 300/LaVanda Wheeler</u> Case No. 2019-CB-0019-C

General Counsel Ellen Strizak presented a memo to the Board and recommended that the Board affirm the Executive Director's Recommended Decision and Order.
