Minutes of the Meeting held on February 15, 2018 At 160 N. LaSalle Street, Chicago, Illinois

I. PRESENT

Chairman Andrea Waintroob; Board Members Lynne Sered, Judy Biggert, Gilbert O'Brien and Lara Shayne; Executive Director Victor Blackwell; General Counsel Susan Willenborg; Associate General Counsel Ellen Strizak; and Board Attorneys Dawn Harden & John F. II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF MEETING HELD JANUARY 18, 2018

III. BOARD ACTIONS

1. Chicago Board of Education/Valentina Sorescu Case No. 2016-CA-0020-C

Chairman Waintroob called the case. This case is before the Board on the Charging Party's exceptions to the Executive Director's Recommended Decision and Order dismissing the unfair labor practice charge. General Counsel Susan Willenborg presented a memo to the Board. After discussion, the Board directed the General Counsel to draft an opinion and order consistent with the recommendation.

2. <u>Homer District 33-C Support Staff Council, Local 604, IFT-AFT, AFL-CIO/Dennis Gutka, et al.</u> Case No. 2017-CB-0003-C, et al.

Chairman Waintroob called the case. General Counsel Susan Willenborg presented a draft opinion and order. After discussion, Chairman Waintroob called for a motion for the Board to issue the opinion and order. Board Member Shayne so moved, and Board Member O'Brien seconded the motion. Board Member Sered added a "concurrence" to the draft opinion and order. The Board voted unanimously to adopt the opinion and order with the revisions, by a voice vote.

3. Northern Illinois University/Peter Suffield Case No. 2017-CA-0038-C

Chairman Waintroob called the case. General Counsel Susan Willenborg presented a draft opinion and order. After discussion, Chairman Waintroob called for a motion for the Board to issue the opinion and order. Board Member Shayne so moved, and Board Member O'Brien seconded the motion. The Board voted unanimously to issue the opinion and order, by a voice vote.

4. Glen Ellyn School District #41/American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 31 Case No. 2017-UC-0019-C

Chairman Waintroob called the case. This case involved an unappealed Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Decision and Order. General Counsel Susan Willenborg presented the case with the corrected typos. After discussion, Chairman Waintroob called for a motion for the Board to not take up the case on its own motion and to issue a final order. Board Member Shayne so moved, and Board Member Biggert seconded the motion. The Board voted unanimously not to take up the case on its own motion and to issue a final order, by a voice vote.

5. Galesburg Community Unit School District 205/Galesburg Education Association, IEA-NEA Case No. 2018-UC-0008-C

8. Service Employees International Union, Local 15/Tracey Dodson Case No. 2017-FS-0062-C

Associate General Counsel Ellen Strizak presented the case with corrected typo to make fee payers without a hyphen. After discussion, Chairman Waintroob called for a motion for the Board to not take up the case on its own motion and to issue a final order. Board Member Biggert so moved, and Board Member Sered seconded the motion. The Board voted unanimously not to take up the case on its own motion and to issue a final order, by a voice vote.

Member Sered seconded the motion. The Board voted unanimously to add Mr. Jones to the roster. Second candidate was Stephen M. Biersmith. After discussion, Chairman Waintroob called for a motion for the Board to vote to add Mr. Biersmith to the roster. Board Member Shayne so moved, and Board Member Biggert seconded the motion. The Board voted unanimously to add Mr. Biersmith to the roster.

XI. UNION DISCLAIMERS OF STATUS AS EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVES

Chairman Waintroob brought up possibility of adopting a process for disclaimer of interest procedure similar to the ILRB in anticipation of the US Supreme Court decision in the <u>Janus</u> case. General Counsel Willenborg discussed the rules change process for such adoption. Executive Director Blackwell indicated that the possible need for this comes from anticipation of the possible outcome in Janus.

XII. JULY THROUGH DECEMBER CLOSED SESSION MINUTES

The vote on whether to make the July through December closed session minutes open was tabled until the March, 2018 meeting and the Board directed General Counsel Willenborg to research two issues.

XIII. CHANGE IN DATE OF MARCH BOARD MEETING
