Minutes of the Meeting held on January 19. 2017 At 160 N. LaSalle Street, Chicago, Illinois

I. <u>OPENING OF THE MEETING AT 10:00 A.M.</u>

II. <u>PRESENT</u>

Chairman Andrea Waintroob; Board Members Judy Biggert, Gilbert O'Brien, Lynne Sered and Lara Shayne; Executive Director Victor Blackwell; General Counsel Susan Willenborg; staff members John Brosnan, Nicholas Gutierrez, Dawn Harden and Ellen Strizak; and observers Melissa Auerbach, Nicholas Christen, Mary Pietrazak and James Powers were present. Staff member Meredith Dean participated via teleconference from the IELRB's Springfield office.

III. <u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF MEETING HELD DECEMBER 15, 2016</u>

Chairman Waintroob called for a motion to approve the minutes of the December 15, 2016 Board meeting. Board Member Biggert moved to approve the minutes of the December 15, 2016 meeting. Board Member Shayne seconded the motion. The Board passed the motion unanimously, by a voice vote.

IV. BOARD ACTIONS

1. <u>Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois/AFSCME, Council 31</u> Case No. 2015-CA-0015-S

Chairman Waitroob called the case. This case was before the Board on the Employer's exceptions to the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Decision and Order finding that the Employer had violated the Act. General Counsel Susan Willenborg presented the case. After discussion, the Board directed that an opinion and order be drafted reversing the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Decision and Order, with a dissent by Board Member Sered.

2. <u>Canton Education Association, IEA-NEA/Donald Bugos</u> Case No. 2017-CB-0001-S

Chairman Waintroob called the case. This case was before the Board on the Charging Party's exceptions to the Executive Director's Recommended Decision and Order dismissing the unfair labor practice charge. General Counsel Susan Willenborg presented a draft opinion and order striking the Charging Party's exceptions. After discussion, Chairman Waintroob called for a motion for the Board to issue the draft opinion and order. Board Member Shayne so moved, and Board Member O'Brien seconded the motion. The Board voted unanimously to issue the draft opinion and order, by a voice vote.

3. <u>Chicago Board of Education/Denise Butler</u> Case No. 2016-CA-0065-C

Chairman Waintroob called the case. This case was before the Board on the Charging Party's exceptions to the Executive Director's Recommended Decision and Order dismissing the unfair labor practice charge. Associate General Counsel Ellen Strizak presented a draft opinion and order affirming the Executive Director's Recommended Decision and Order. After discussion, Chairman Waintroob called for a motion for the Board to issue the draft opinion and order. Board Member Shayne so moved, and Board Member O'Brien seconded the motion. The Board voted unanimously to issue the draft opinion and order, by a voice vote.

4. <u>Oswego Transportation Association, IEA-NEA/Maryann Walker</u> Case No. 2017-CB-0002-C

Chairman Waintroob called the case. This case involved an unappealed Executive Director's Recommended Decision and Order dismissing the unfair labor practice charge. Associate General Counsel Ellen Strizak presented the case. After discussion, Chairman Waintroob called for a motion for the Board not to take up the case on its own motion and to issue a final order. Board Member Biggert so moved, and Board Member O'Brien seconded the motion. The Board voted unanimously not to take up the case on its own motion and to issue a final order, by a voice vote.

5. <u>Valley View Council, Local No. 604, IFT-AFT, AFL-CIO/</u> <u>Jennifer Cook</u> Case No. 2016-CB-0017-C

Chairman Waintroob called the case. This case involved an unappealed Executive Director's Recommended Decision and Order dismissing the unfair labor practice charge. Associate General Counsel Ellen Strizak presented the case. After discussion, Chairman Waintroob called for a motion for the Board not to take up the case on its own motion and to issue a final order. Board Member Sered so moved, and Board Member Biggert seconded the motion. The Board voted unanimously not to take up the case on its own motion and to issue a final order, by a voice vote.

V. <u>PROPOSED ADDITION TO MEDIATION ROSTER</u>

Chairman Waintroob called the matter. Staff attorney John Brosnan presented the proposed addition to the mediation roster. After discussion, Chairman Waintroob called for a motion for the Board to approve the proposed addition to the mediation roster. Board Member Shayne so moved, and Board Member Sered seconded the motion. The Board voted unanimously to approve the proposed addition to the mediation roster, by a voice vote.

VI. <u>REVIEW OF CLOSED SESSION MINUTES</u>
