II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF MEETING HELD October 19, 2017

Chairman Waintroob called for a motion to approve the minutes of the October 19, 2017 Board meeting. Board Member Shayne moved to approve the minutes of the October 19, 2017 meeting. Board Member Biggert seconded the motion. The Board passed the motion unanimously, by a voice vote.

III. BOARD ACTIONS

1. <u>Community Consolidated School District 15/Educational Support Personnel Association, IEA-NEA</u>

Case No. 2018-CA-0029-C

(Oral Argument on request for preliminary relief)

Chairman Waintroob called the case. Elizabeth Reynolds, for the IEA-NEA, presented an oral argument to the Board in support of its motion for preliminary injunctive relief. Jason Manning, for Community Consolidated School District 15, presented an oral argument to the Board in opposition to Union's motion for preliminary relief. Associate General Counsel Ellen M. Strizak made a recommendation to the Board. The Board voted to deny the union's request for injunctive relief. Board Member Shayne so moved, and Board Member Biggert seconded the motion.

2. Rock Valley College/Rock Valley College Support Staff, Local 6569, IFT-AFT, AFL-CIO

Case Nos. 2017-CA-0031-C and 2017-CA-0045-C (Request for preliminary injunctive relief)

Chairman Waintroob called the case. General Counsel Susan Willenborg presented a draft opinion and order denying preliminary injunctive relief. After discussion, Chairman Waintroob called for

a motion for the Board to issue the opinion and order. Board Member O'Brien so moved, and Board Member Biggert seconded the motion. The Board voted unanimously to issue the opinion and order, by a voice vote, with a footnote by Board Member Sered.

3. Chicago Board of Education/Raymond Gora Case No. 2013-CA-0072-C
